



Gary Dulabaum Concerts and Entertainment

Gary Dulabaum was born into a musical family in Uniontown, Ohio and got the bug for performing while still in high school. In his early twenties he began performing at the old Boulder Junction Coffeehouse in his hometown doing stand-up comedy, emceeing, working the door and performing in old timey string bands. Comedian Drew Carey even performed there in his early days as did many other incredible musicians and performers who would inspire Gary nightly.

These days Gary is a high-energy multi-instrumentalist (banjo, guitar, mandolin & autoharp), singer/songwriter who continues to perform and entertain audiences of all ages over 200 days a year throughout the United States and other countries at festivals, night clubs, schools, business conventions, cruise ships, casinos, ski resorts, coffee houses, farmer's markets, concert halls, summer recreation programs, libraries, family celebrations, conferences and special events celebrating children and families.

As an entertainer, Gary's performances never fail to touch the heart. He has the rare gift of captivating audiences of all ages with his music, his quick wit, and his humorous monologues (he has been called "screamingly funny"). Gary understands how people feel and interact. With this understanding he uses his music to convey the core of human experience. Audiences just don't observe Gary—they participate with him.

Gary's original songs are a mix of Americana, rock, country, bluegrass, swing, jazz, and old timey string band music that suit his spirited vocals and energetic, yet expressive, 5 string banjo (Gary plays clawhammer, two finger and three finger picking styles) and guitar playing. Whether he is performing an original song, a traditional old timey tune, or a favorite cover, Gary's arrangements are all his own.

Gary's main influences as a songwriter and performer include his father Marion - whose music-playing motivated Gary to be a musician; Pete Seeger - whose banjo playing of the song "John Henry" inspired Gary to learn banjo; and Robert Frost, Bob Dylan, The Band, Danny O'Keefe and Nikki Giovanni - whose writings inspired Gary to write his own poems and lyrics.
